- For two recently-arrived Middle Eastern men who secured their driver’s licenses and vehicles for their families’ transportation. Both are fellow servants in Christ who desire to be devoted to serving the unreached diaspora M background communities in our region.
- For God’s continuing care for KA, a father and grandfather who arrived 16 months ago and who is battling late stage cancer.
- For warm friendships and a clear statement of the Gospel as the women of Hayat gathered for a clothing exchange and time together at our place on April 9.

Ask our Lord . . .

- For saving grace to be extended to KA and his wife and other family members, drawing them to repentance and faith, as we and others share the Truth of the Good News with them.
- For Spirit-empowered teaching of God’s Word as Leslie teaches the children, and Scott teaches the adult group at Hayat Fellowship on May 4.
- For the parents of several M families to give permission for their children to participate in the Day Camp June 23-27, as we visit and assist them to register their children.
- For good preparation as the high school team of 8 young women and 5 young men (with four adult leaders) engage in training and prepare to lead during the Day Camp in late June.
- For wisdom and discernment as we assist families facing financial needs with limited opportunities for additional work and income. We also are needing to assist with issues normally cared for by case managers who are currently furloughed due to limited funding.
- To give wisdom to Leslie and grace to her mother as Leslie assists her mother in a transition to more care in the retirement community where she lives. Pray that our Lord will sustain her mother in this season of her long life (soon to be 100 in July).
